



# Rail Outward Mission to Singapore & Malaysia: 24 - 27 October 2016

*UK railway suppliers are invited to join a trade mission to Singapore and Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, in October 2016 to learn about regional rail projects and meet key stakeholders.*

The Mission will take place in Singapore on 24 and 25 October, flying early evening to Kuala Lumpur for a programme on 26 and 27 October.

In Singapore, the government's ongoing development is to double its metro (MRT) system network by 2030, in total spending around £30bn on infrastructure projects. After the projects announced are delivered, Singapore will have four new railway lines and extensions to two others.

Other areas of opportunity include a High Speed Rail line between Singapore and Kuala Lumpur by 2026, a Rapid Transit Link between Singapore and Malaysia and an on-going renewals programme on older Singaporean lines.

Subject to final confirmation, the mission in Singapore will include:

- Group Meeting, including updates on MRT and HSR projects and procurement processes, and themed break-out sessions with the Land Transport Authority (LTA);
- Lunch: networking lunch with LTA senior management and project officials;
- LTA-facilitated visit to an MRT station construction site;
- Meetings with the two rail operators, SMRT and SBST, to hear about upcoming projects and procurement;
- Lunch: networking lunch with SBST or SMRT;
- Networking Reception at the British High Commission, including local and international companies operating in Singapore.

In Malaysia, the mission, which will be of interest to both prime and supply chain companies, focuses on high value rail opportunities. This fast-growing market is investing significantly in rail and includes High-Speed Rail between Malaysia and Singapore along with Kuala Lumpur's three major new MRT lines.

Subject to final confirmation, the mission is planned to include:

- A rail-related networking reception at the British High Commissioners Residence
- Attendance at a DIT-arranged seminar with presentations from the local rail industry (MyHSR, Prasarana, SPAD, MRCB/MMC Gamuda (TBC).
- UK delegates will get a brief opportunity to introduce their products and services at the same seminar and provide brochures for a table top display.
- Take part in group meetings with key local decision makers
- Attend a 'Doing Business in Malaysia' event and meet local rail businesses.
- Briefing by MRT Corp on MRT projects followed by a site visit

#### Costs, Travel and Accommodation

Missioners will be responsible for their own flight bookings and hotel costs; a detailed programme and schedule will be provided and block hotel reservations made. A delegate fee of £300 is payable for the event management & programme.

The mission is limited to a maximum of 2 delegates per company.
