Prior to the Global Financial Crisis in 2008, Mr Wilson moved to Vietnam and joined Dragon Capital to raise and manage the Vietnam Property Fund, a listed vehicle with a mandate to invest in property projects and companies in the growing Vietnamese property market. Mr Wilson has co-invested with large scale investors such as GIC and Warburg Pincus and has several sovereign and institutional investors who participate in the fund and other real estate vehicles.
